

# On Sunday, November 16th Edmonton Transit will Introduce the Following Service Changes:

# **New Routes** 98

93 St. 29 DOWNTOWN NORTHGATE

A new mainline route has been created to operate between North-gate Shopping Centre and 101 Street Downtown. Route 29 will operate weekdays, weekends and holidays along 97 and 101 Streets, supplementing service offered by express buses. Route 29 will be especially convenient for travel between Northgate and the Royal Alexandria Hospital area. Frequency of service will be every 30 minutes from 5:30 a.m. to after midnight.

A new industrial route will operate A new industrial route will operate weekdays throughout the day between the Jasper Place Transit Centre at 156 St./100 A Avenue through the Northwest Industrial area to 142 St./118 Ave. Route 98 begins as a daytime route: operating every 20 minutes during peak hours, every 30 minutes during mid-day, between 6:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. weekdays.

FREQUENCY IMPROVEMENTS Edmonton Transit is pleased to add service on various route at greater frequency than previously. Please check **NEW** route brochures for details.

Sunday afternoon service is now added. Frequency every 15 minutes.

12,16 . . Late night service weekdays and Saturday has been improved to every 30 minutes. On Sundays and holidays, service will be every 30 minutes from 11:00 a.m. to 6:30 p.m.

18 .....15 minute service is extended to 9:30 p.m., and the-schedule is adjusted for improved evening connections with the LRT.

54 .....15 minute service is implemented from Southgate to Kaskitayo in both morning and afternoon peak hours.

The basic 30 minute service will operate to Kaskitayo

until 9:30 p.m. weeknights. .....15 minute service is implemented in both morning and afternoon peak hours.

65,81 ... Late night service is adjusted by adding an extra-

trip. .....An extra trip is added between Millwoods and Southgate Transit Centre.

#### 88 NORTHGATE CASTLE DOWNS

A major extension on Route 88 has been created to provide service further into Castle Downs. Route 88 will now travel along 158 and 162. Avenues through Dunluce Bounluce Bounluce Avenue to the Castle Downs Transit Centre. Route 88 now expands its service throughout the day on weekdays, and adds Saturday service. Frequency will remain every 30 minutes.



#### 44 NORTH OTTEWELL DOWNTOWN

Route 44 has been extended on 56 Street to 82 Avenue, ending at 50 Street, to provide service into the industrial area. Downtown, Route 44 will no longer travel to 106 and 107 Street, but will now loop from 103 to 102 Street. Minor schedule adjustments have occurred to accommodate these route changes.


Route 45 has also been extended on 56 Street to 82 Avenue, ending at 50 Street, to provide service into the industrial area. Its night, Sunday and holiday route will remain unchanged, however.

# Route Changes from U





Project Uni brings a new network of oneway roads to and from Downtown, and on November 16 the High Level Bridge becomes one-way southbound. Walterdale Hill Road and the 105th Street Bridge become oneway northbound. At the same time, construction around Government Centre is finished sufficiently to allow 97 Avenue to be reopened to traffic.

Edmonton Transit is rerouting buses to use these new traffic arteries. New route brochures have been produced: 9, 32, 40, 41, 42, 43, 46/64, 49, 51, 52, 56, 61, 62, 63, 77, 83, and 154.

There are some patterns easily learned about the routes:

- \* Routes 43, 63 and 83 will now use 97
  Avenue between 105 and 109 Streets.
  Route 77 will continue westbound on 97
  Avenue from the James Macdonald Bridge.
  These routes also use the High Level
  Bridge southbound and the 105th Street
  Bridge northbound.
- \* Routes 49, 51, 52, 61, 62 and 154 will continue to operate as expresses, not stopping in the river valley. They will use 97 Avenue, the High Level Bridge south-bound and the 105th Street Bridge north-bound.
- \* Routes 9, 32, 40, 41, 42, 46, 56 and 64 will use 101 Street southbound, Bellamy Hill and 97 Avenue, the High Level Bridge southbound, onto their regular routes. Northbound all follow Walterdale Hill Road, the 105th Street Bridge to Bellamy Hill and their regular routes. These buses make stops throughout the river valley's Walterdale and Rossdale areas. Individuals interested in using the Kinsmen Field House and Commonwealth Pool should request transfers when boarding buses to connect to these routes.

Edmonton Transit assures patrons that traffic regulation and the one-way roadways will help traffic move more smoothly through the river valley. Let Edmonton Transit Take You There!



# Proof of Payment on LRT

Effective November 19, all passengers on Edmonton Transit's LRT may be required to produce proof of payment for the trip. Any valid Edmonton Transit pass or transfer may be used, or a POP receipt. That's the receipt provided in LRT entrances by new coin-operated machines which go into operation on November 19. Remember these machines accept only coins, so bring exact coin fares into the LRT if you're not a pass or transfer user! LRT is the POPular way to travel!
