
## **Using Your Route Schedule**

This timetable has the specific travel times of the route listed on the upper front of the bus. The purpose of route brochures is to help customers plan their travel time and reduce unnecessary waiting at bus stops. Although difficulties in traffic may delay some buses, our Operators strive to maintain the schedule time printed in brochures.

Below is a diagram explaining what each area of the brochure represents.



#### **Timing Points**

Main stops at timing points are listed on the schedule; however, buses will stop at other bus stops not listed Reading the times from left to right gives you the travel time from point to point. Reading top to bottom shows you how frequently buses travel; ie: every 15, 30 or 60 minutes.

Notes are made to show low floor bus service or a departure from regular service. Trips to Government Centre are indicated on the


# Route 66 Revised June 27, 199
